## YOUTH COVENANT

I covenant with other Faith youth and adult leaders and with the ASP staff to responsibly prepare for the ASP mission experience. I will:

- Attend study sessions dealing with the traditions, customs, and values of the Appalachia
  people so that my response to the housing needs may be carried out with sensitivity and
  respectfulness of their culture.
- Participate in group construction practice sessions to prepare myself for the construction tasks I will be given.
- Participate in fund raising events as we prepare for our week in Appalachia
- Cooperate with the ASP staff in carrying out the responsibilities of our home repair assignment and center tasks
- Abide by the ASP Expectations and Regulations.
- Continue to develop an attitude of **open-mindedness** to meet the challenges of home repair, new ideas, and new friends; an attitude of **open-heartedness** to give my gift of love and labor as a free gift and to receive the gifts given me with humility and gratitude; and an attitude of **acceptance** of myself, of other youth and adults in the Faith group, of youth and adults at the center, and of our Appalachia family remembering that it is our similarities that bind us together in community.
- Give 6 hours of service through UMYF and/or ASP service opportunities prior to departure.
- Participate in the ASP worship service when we return as we share our stories of faith with the congregation.
- Follow up my week in Appalachia by continuing to include service as an important part of my personal life, by responding to the needs of my church and the larger community of Champaign-Urbana.
